The 150 year old structure houses memorabilia from the time when R.B. Chamberlin was the town dentist and pianos were upright. Trustees will be on hand to answer questions from 5:00 to 8:00. Barn tours are available too. Hear what the barn was like when Dr. Freeman parked his buggy there and before it was decorated with the iconic Mail pouch sign.

In 1847, the Congregationalists build a new Church on the west side of the Square. The Institute purchases the old Church that Rev. Bissell helped build in 1831. School attendance reaches 300 with 50 to 70 boarders.

**1845** – Jonathan E Herrick built a large stone home near the corner of Old Mill Road and Rt. 91. In 1860 his daughter Electra marries Ethan Lewis Alling, son of Ethan Alling. Mr. Herrick was president of the association responsible for the Civil War monument built on the Square in 1867. In 1981 this home was disassembled and moved to Hale Farm where it remains on display.
