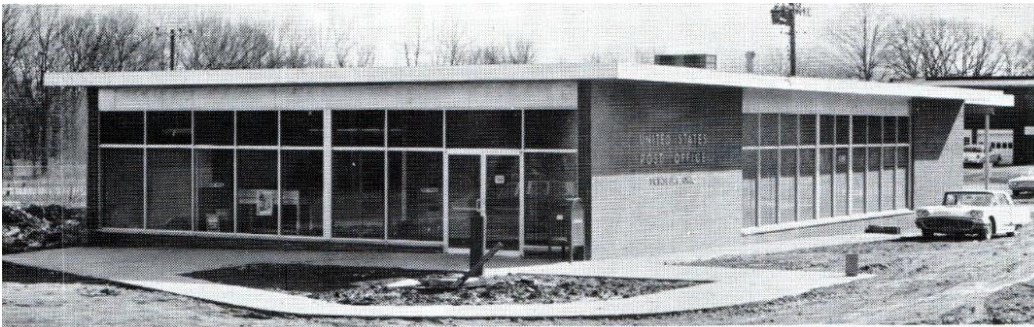
**1960** - Wilcox Elementary School was built. R. B. Chamberlin High had an auditorium, gymnasium, and shop areas added
